An Act to amend the Opticians Act, 1920.

[Assented to, December 21st, 1922.]

E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Opticians Act short titles. Amendment Act, 1922."
- (2) The Opticians Act, 1920 (hereinafter called "the principal No. 1443 of 1920. Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Opticians Acts, 1920 and 1922."
- 2. Section 20 of the principal Act is hereby amended by striking Amendment of out in the thirteenth and fourteenth lines of subdivision (a) thereof principal Act. the words "within six months after the commencement of this Act" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "before the thirtyfirst day of March, 1923."

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
