An Act to amend the Ombudsman Act, 1972.

[Assented to 28 March 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Ombudsman Act Amendment Act, 1985".

(2) The Ombudsman Act, 1972, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which the Police (Complaints and Disciplinary Proceedings) Act, 1985, comes into operation.

Amendment of
s. 5—
Non-application
of Act.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:

(2) This Act does not apply to or in relation to—

(a) any complaint to which the Police (Complaints and Disciplinary Proceedings) Act, 1985, applies;

or

(b) any matter to which that Act would apply if the matter were the subject of a complaint under that Act.
