An Act to amend the Ombudsman Act, 1972.

[Assented to 8 September 1988]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Ombudsman Act Amendment Act, 1988.
- (2) The Ombudsman Act, 1972, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Persons who may make complaints

2. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (4) "\$500" and substituting "\$2 000".

Insertion of s. 15a

3. The following section is inserted after section 15 of the principal Act:

Offence in relation to complaints

15a. A person who—

(a) prevents another person from making a complaint under this Act;

(b) hinders or obstructs another person in making a complaint under this Act, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: \$2 000.

Secrecy

4. Section 22 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) "\$500" and substituting "\$2 000".

5. Section 24 of the principal Act is amended by striking out "\$500" and substituting **"\$**2 000".
