An Act to amend the Office for the Ageing Act 1995.

[Assented to 18 November 1999]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Office for the Ageing (Advisory Board) Amendment Act 1999*.

(2) The *Office for the Ageing Act 1995* is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 8—Advisory Board

3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (2) and substituting the following paragraph:

(b) not less than six, and not more than 10, other persons with relevant expertise appointed by the Minister.;

(b) by striking out subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:

(3) At least three members of the Board must be women and three men.

(c) by striking out from subsection (5) "four" and substituting "six".
