An Act to amend the Offenders Probation Act, 1913-1934.

[Assented to 20th December, 1945.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Offenders Probation Act Amendment Act, 1945".

(2) The Offenders Probation Act, 1913-1934, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Offenders Probation Act, 1913-1945".

(3) The Offenders Probation Act, 1913-1934, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (c) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—

(c) such additional conditions with respect to residence, abstention from intoxicating liquor, and any other matters, as the court may, having regard to the particular circumstances of the case, consider necessary or desirable for preventing a repetition of the same offence or the commission of other offences.
