An Act to amend the law relating to persons apprenticed to pharmaceutical chemists registered pursuant to the Pharmacy Act, 1935-1936.

[Assented to 3rd November, 1937.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Pharmacy Act Amendment Act, 1937 ". Short titles.

(2) The Pharmacy Act, 1935-1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Pharmacy Act, 1935-1937 ".

(3) The Pharmacy Act, 1935-1936, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act ".

2. Part V. of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after section 33 the following section :— Amendment of principal Act, Part V.—

33a. Section 223 of the Industrial Code, 1920, shall not apply and shall be deemed never to have applied to any apprentice to a registered pharmaceutical chemist. Non-application of section 223 of the Industrial Code, 1920.
