## No. 57 of 1965

An Act to amend the Prices Act, 1948-1964, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 23rd December, 1965.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prices Act Amendment Short titles. Act, 1965".
- (2) The Prices Act, 1948-1964, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prices Act, 1948-1965".
- (3) The Prices Act, 1948-1964, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting Amendment of principal Act, therein after subsection (2) thereof the following subsection:

s. 3— Interpretation.

(3) Where a maximum price or rate in relation to goods or services fixed by or under this Act in force on the fourteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, is expressed in terms of the Coinage Act 1909-1947, of the Commonwealth, the amount of such maximum price or rate shall on and after that day be the amount so expressed in terms of that currency or the 342

equivalent amount in terms of the currency provided by the Currency Act 1965, of the Commonwealth, calculated on the basis that the equivalent of one pound is two dollars, the equivalent of one shilling is ten cents and the equivalent of an amount of pence, or pence and half pence is an amount of cents specified in the second column of the table at the foot of this section opposite to the amount of pence or pence and half pence specified in the first column of that table and every order made under this Act fixing and declaring a maximum price or rate in force on the fourteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, in relation to goods or services shall be read and construed and effect given thereto accordingly.
