### No. 3 of 1963

An Act to amend the Pulp and Paper Mill (Hundred of Gambier) Indenture Act, 1961, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 20th June, 1963.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Pulp and Paper Mill (Hundred of Gambier) Indenture Act Amendment Act, 1963". Short titles.
- (2) The Pulp and Paper Mill (Hundred of Gambier) Indenture Act, 1961, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Pulp and Paper Mill (Hundred of Gambier) Indenture Act, 1961-1963".
- (3) The Pulp and Paper Mill (Hundred of Gambier) Indenture Act, 1961, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation
3. Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-clause (3) of clause 2 of the Indenture set out in the Schedule to the principal Act, the time for the giving of notice as provided in that sub-clause is hereby extended to the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three. Extension of time for giving notice under Indenture.
