An Act to authorise the construction of Reservoirs, Tanks, Wells, and other Works for the purpose of affording a Supply of Water to the District of Port Augusta.

[Assented to, 25th October, 1879.]

**W**HEREAS it is desirable to authorise the construction of Preamble.  
reservoirs, tanks, wells, and other works for the purpose of affording a supply of water to the District of Port Augusta, according as the said district is defined in the Schedule hereto, and whereas plans and sections showing the source of supply, and the said reservoirs, tanks, wells, and other works, and the direction of the main and branch pipes, and the street and grounds through which they are to be laid, and also books of reference containing the names of the owners and occupiers, or reputed owners and occupiers (so far as known), of any private lands through which any of the said works will pass, have been deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General, at Adelaide—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament here assembled, as follows:

1. The Commissioner of Waterworks may construct, out of any moneys which have been or hereafter may be voted by Parliament for such purpose, the reservoirs, tanks, wells, and other works in accordance with the plans and sections deposited as aforesaid in the office of the Surveyor-General, at Adelaide. Commissioner of Waterworks may construct reservoirs, tanks, and other works.

2. If any error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description shall have been made of any lands or streams, or of the owners or occupiers Errors and omissions in plans, &c., may be corrected by Justices, &c.

occupiers, or reputed owners or occupiers, of any lands or streams delineated or shown on the said plans or sections, or described in the books of reference deposited as aforesaid, the Commissioner of Waterworks, after giving ten days' notice to the owners or occupiers, or reputed owners or occupiers, of the lands or streams affected or likely to be affected by the correction of such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description, may apply to any two Justices to correct the same; and if it shall appear to such Justices that it is expedient and not unjust to correct such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description, they shall give the said Commissioner a certificate in such form as they shall think proper, and shall in such certificate state the particulars of any such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description, and such certificate, with the documents to which it refers, shall be deposited, with the other documents to which they refer, in the office of the Surveyor-General, and thereupon such plans, sections, or books of reference shall be deemed to be corrected according to such certificate, and the said Commissioner may make, complete, extend, and maintain the works hereby authorised in accordance with such certificate, as if such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description had not been made.

Surveyor-General to

**3.** The Surveyor-General shall keep the said plans and sections, and books of reference, and all other documents deposited with him for the purpose of this Act, and shall allow all persons interested to inspect any of the documents aforesaid, and to make copies of and from the same.

Incorporation.

**4.** Except so far as the same are inconsistent with or altered by this Act, "The Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act," "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act," and an Act No. 26 of 1855-6, intituled "An Act to amend the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act," shall be incorporated herewith, and for the purposes of this Act the expression "the promoters of the undertaking" whenever used in "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act" shall mean the Commissioner of Waterworks, and the words "special Act" shall mean this Act.

Interpretation.

**5.** In the construction of and for the purposes of this Act and "The Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act," when not inconsistent with the context, the expression the "undertaking" shall, in addition to the meaning assigned thereto by the said "The Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act," mean and include the reservoirs, tanks, wells, and other works hereby authorised to be constructed. The expression "lands and streams" shall, in addition to the meaning assigned thereto by the said Act, mean and include the lands and streams of water hereby authorised to be taken or used for the purposes hereof, and the expression "water-area" shall, in addition to the meaning assigned thereto by the said Act, mean and include the District of Port Augusta, according as the boundaries thereof are defined in the Schedule hereto.

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**6.** This Act may be for all purposes cited as the “Port Augusta Waterworks Act, 1879.” Short title.

## SCHEDULE.

*Port Augusta Water Area.*

Commencing at the north-eastern corner of section 880, Hundred of Davenport; thence west north-westerly along the northern boundary of said section, the southern boundary of section 881, and northern boundary of section 872, and its production west-north-westerly to the eastern side of road east of section 235; thence northerly across the railway, and northerly and north-north-easterly along the eastern side of road east of sections 252, 349, and 360, to its intersection with the northern side of road north of said section; thence north-westerly along north-eastern side of road north-east of sections 360, 397, 448, and 499, to the western side of road west of the latter section; thence south-south-westerly along western side of road west of sections 499, 504, and 533, to the eastern corner of section 853; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of sections 853 and 850, and south-westerly along the north-western boundary of the latter to the north-eastern boundary of the corporate town of Port Augusta; thence north-westerly to the northern corner of allotment 116; thence west-south-westerly by a straight line to the eastern corner of the township of Port Augusta West; thence north-westerly along its north-eastern boundary to its northern corner; thence south-westerly along its north-western boundary to the south-western side of Loudon's Road; thence south-easterly along said side of road, and south-south-easterly along the western side of said road to the north-western side of Caroon Road; thence south-westerly along said side of road, and southerly along the south-west boundary of the township to its southern corner; thence south-easterly by a straight line to the south-western corner of the corporate town of Port Augusta, the western corner of allotment 1; thence south-westerly and southerly along the south-western boundary of said corporate town, and its production to the centre line of the Port Augusta and Government Gums Railway; thence north-north-easterly and south-easterly along said railway line to the north-western side of road north-west of section 1; thence south-westerly along said side of road to the south-western side of road south-west of said section; thence generally in a south-easterly direction, following the south-western side of road south-west of sections 1, 40, 65, and 90, southern side of road south of sections 140, 164, and 169, and south-western side of road south-west of sections 183, 200, and 220, to a point south of the south-western corner of section 866; thence northerly to said corner and east-south-easterly along the southern boundaries of sections 866, 867, 868, 869, and their production to the eastern boundary of section 870; thence north-north-easterly along portion of the eastern boundary of said section, and the eastern boundary of section 880, to the point of commencement.
