An Act to amend the Public Charities Funds Acts, 1912 to 1923, and for other purposes.

*[Assented to, September 30th, 1926.]*

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Charities Funds Act Further Amendment Act, 1926." Short titles.

(2) The Public Charities Funds Acts, 1912 to 1923, and this Act may be cited together as the "Public Charities Funds Acts, 1912 to 1926."

(3) The Public Charities Funds Act, 1912, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act" No. 1078 of 1912.

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "land" in the fifth line thereof the passage "in the purchase or acquisition of any chattel real or other interest in land," Amendment of principal Act, s. 11. Power to purchase chattel real.

Powers of Commissioners to accept leases and surrenders of leases.

4. In addition to any powers conferred by the Acts incorporated with this Act, the Commissioners shall have power upon such terms and conditions as the Commissioners think fit—

- (a) to accept the surrender or partial surrender of any lease, underlease, or tenancy:
- (b) to take a lease or underlease of any land or any interest therein.

Retrospective operation of Act.

5. The principal Act and this Act shall be read as if the provisions of section 3 and section 4 of this Act had at the time of the passing of the principal Act been included therein.
