**An Act to amend the Potato Marketing Act, 1948.**

*[Assented to 6 June 1985]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Potato Marketing Act Amendment Act, 1985".

(2) The Potato Marketing Act, 1948, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment to s. 21—  
Offences and penalties.

2. Section 21 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "and in the case of a person convicted of the offence of selling, purchasing, delivering or taking delivery of potatoes in contravention of an order made under this Act, to an additional penalty of an amount equal to the value of the potatoes in relation to the sale, purchase or delivery of which he was so convicted ascertained in accordance with the provisions of subsection (2) of this section";

and

(b) by striking out subsection (2).

Insertion of new s. 26.

3. The following section is inserted after section 25 of the principal Act:

Expiry of Act.

26. (1) This Act shall expire on the thirtieth day of June, 1987.

(2) On the expiration of this Act, all property rights and liabilities vested in or attached to the board immediately before that expiration shall vest in or attach to the Minister.

(3) The Minister shall, after satisfying all liabilities of the board, distribute the remaining assets of the board (if any) between persons who have been registered or licensed under this Act in such manner as the Minister thinks fit.
