An Act to amend the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1960.

[Assented to 5th November, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prevention of Cruelty short uttoe. to Animals Act Amendment Act, 1964".
- (2) The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1960, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1964".
- (3) The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1960, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
 - 3. Section 21 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of principal Act, s. 21—

- (a) by inserting after the word "constable" (wherever Killing of occurring) in subsection (2) thereof the words "or veterinary surgeon" in each case; and
- (b) by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection:—

(3) In subsection (2) of this section, "veterinary surgeon" means a person who is registered as a veterinary surgeon pursuant to section 17 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1935-1957.
