An Act to make further provision for the payment of
Members of Parliament.

[Assented to 7th December, 1944.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament
thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Payment of Members of
Parliament Act, 1944".

Payment of
members of
Parliament
other than
Ministers.

2. Every member of Parliament, not being a Minister of the
Crown, shall in addition to any salary, annual sum or other
payment to which he is entitled out of the General Revenue
of the State, be entitled to receive an additional sum at the
rate of two hundred pounds per annum.

Application of
certain
enactments.

3. Sections 4 and 5 of the Payment of Members of Parliament
Act, 1936, shall apply in relation to the payments provided
for by this Act in like manner as they apply to the payments
provided for in that Act.

This Act to
apply notwith-
standing other
Acts.

4. This Act shall apply notwithstanding the provisions of
any Act in force at the time of the passing of this Act.
