An Act to amend the Police Act 1952.

[Assented to 2 June 1994]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Police (Surrender of Property on Suspension) Amendment Act 1994.

(2) The Police Act 1952 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 20—Duty of former or suspended member of police force or police cadet to deliver up equipment, etc.

2. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) "A person who for any reason ceases to be a member of the police force or police cadet must forthwith" and substituting the following:

"A person who for any reason—

- (a) ceases to be a member of the police force or police cadet; or
- (b) is suspended pursuant to this Act from his or her appointment as a member of the police force or police cadet,

must immediately".

Amendment of s. 34—Duty of former or suspended special constable to deliver up equipment, etc.

3. Section 34 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) "A person who for any reason ceases to be a special constable must forthwith" and substituting the following:

"A person who for any reason-

- (a) ceases to be a special constable; or
- (b) is suspended pursuant to this Act from his or her appointment as a special constable,

must immediately".
