An Act to provide for the payment of Pension under the Police Pensions Act, 1929, to Louise Eugenie Forster.

[Assented to, September 18th, 1930.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Police Pensions Act, 1930," and is incorporated with the Police Pensions Act, 1929.

Short title and incorporation.

2. Louise Eugenie Forster, formerly Woman Police Constable in the Police Force of South Australia (who has been in the employment of the Commissioner of Police since the 26th day of March, 1917, but whose service as a member of the Force within the meaning of the Police Pensions Act, 1929, commenced on the 20th day of December, 1927), shall be entitled upon retirement to pension under section 15 of the Police Pensions Act, 1929.

Payment of pension to L. E. Forster.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
