An Act to authorise the Treasurer to raise moneys to the amount of five hundred thousand pounds for various public works, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, 30th July, 1936.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Purposes Loan Act, Short title. 1936".
- 2. In this Act "Financial Agreement" means the Financial Interpretation. Agreement made between the Commonwealth and all the States of Australia and ratified by the Financial Agreement Act, 1927.
- 3. The Treasurer may arrange for the sum of five hundred Power to borrow. thousand pounds to be borrowed in accordance with the Financial Agreement on behalf of the State.
- 4. All sums of money borrowed under section 3 of this Act Application shall be applied to the several purposes set forth in the first schedule to this Act, and to the extent set forth in that schedule; and shall be applied by the Treasurer in such amounts and manner as the Governor, by warrant under his hand, countersigned by the Chief Secretary, from time to time authorises and directs.
- 5. All salaries of officers, payable out of moneys borrowed salaries to be submitted to under this Act, shall be annually submitted to Parliament.

Advances

6. The Governor may, by warrant countersigned by the Chief Secretary, authorise the Treasurer to advance to the proper responsible Minister of the Crown, for the purposes of this Act, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the amount authorised by this Act to be borrowed; and an amount equal to the sums of money so advanced shall be retained by the Treasurer out of any moneys borrowed under the authority of this Act, and applied in repayment of the moneys so advanced.

Power to borrow money for expenses incurred.

7. In addition to the amount of five hundred thousand pounds authorised by section 3 of this Act to be borrowed, there may be borrowed under that section such sum as will be sufficient to pay all discounts, charges, and other expenses incurred in connection with the borrowing of that amount of five hundred thousand pounds, and the amount of those discounts, charges, and other expenses shall be charged proportionately to the several purposes set forth in the first schedule to this Act.

Re-application of repaid loan moneys.

- 8. (1) In this section and in the following section "repaid loan moneys" means money received by the Treasurer in repayment of advances made or other sums expended out of moneys borrowed under any Act.
- (2) The Treasurer may apply any repaid loan moneys for the time being in his hands to the several purposes set forth in the second schedule to this Act and to the extent therein set forth, and in such amount and manner as the Governor by warrant under his hand countersigned by the Chief Secretary from time to time authorises and directs.

Entries of repayments in Treasury accounts.

9. Whenever the Treasurer receives any repaid loan moneys he shall make a reduction corresponding to the amount so received, in the debits of the appropriate loan accounts in the books of the Treasurer.
