An Act to amend the Public Purposes Loan Act, 1915.

[Assented to, November 20th, 1919.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Public Purposes Loan Act Amendment Act, 1919." Short titles.

(2) The Public Purposes Loan Act, 1915 (hereinafter called "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Public Purposes Loan Acts, 1915 and 1919." Amendment of principal Act, s. 2. Power to borrow £9,266,500.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "bearing not more than five per centum annual interest", in the fourth line thereof, the words "bearing interest at such rate as the Treasurer thinks fit on the respective amounts thereof."

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
