An Act to authorise the construction of a Dam, Wells, and other Works for the purpose of supplying Port Pirie with Water.

[Assented to, 25th October, 1879.]

THEREAS it is desirable to authorise the construction of a dam, Preamble. wells, and other works for the purpose of supplying the District of Port Pirie, the boundaries whereof are described in the Schedule hereto, with water: And whereas plans and sections showing the source of supply, and also the said dam, wells, and other works, and the direction of the main and branch pipes, and the streets and grounds through which they are to be laid, and also books of reference, containing the names of the owners or occupiers (so far as known) of any private lands on which the said dam, wells, and other works will be constructed, or through which the same will pass, have been deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General at Adelaide—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. The Commissioner of Waterworks may construct, out of any Commissioner of Waterworks may construct by Parlia- Struct dam, wells, and ment for such purpose, the said dam, wells, and other works, in other works. accordance with the plans and sections deposited as aforesaid in the office of the Surveyor-General, at Adelaide.

2. If any error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description Errors and omissions shall have been made of any lands or streams, or of the owners or corrected by Justices, occupiers

occupiers, or reputed owners or occupiers, of any lands or streams delineated or shown on the said plan or sections, or described in the books of reference deposited as aforesaid, the Commissioner of Waterworks, after giving ten days notice to the owners or occupiers, or reputed owners or occupiers, of the lands or streams affected or likely to be affected by the correction of such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description, may apply to any two Justices to correct the same; and if it shall appear to such Justices that it is expedient, and not unjust, to correct such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description, they shall give the said Commissioner a certificate in such form as they think proper, and shall, in such certificate, state the particulars of any such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description, and such certificate, with the documents to which it refers, shall be deposited, with the other documents to which they refer, in the office of the Surveyor-General, and thereupon such plans, sections, or books of reference shall be deemed to be corrected according to such certificate, and the said Commissioner may make, complete, extend, and maintain the works hereby authorised in accordance with such certificate, as if such error, omission, misstatement, or wrong description had not been made.

Surveyor-General to keep plans, &c.

3. The Surveyor-General shall keep the said plans and sections and books of reference and all other documents deposited with him for the purposes of this Act, and shall allow all persons interested to inspect any of the documents aforesaid and to make copies of and from the same.

Incorporation.

4. Except so far as the same are inconsistent with or altered by this Act, "The Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act," "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act," and an Act, No. 26, of 1855-6, intituled "An Act to amend the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act," shall be incorporated herewith, and for the purposes of this Act the expression "the promoters of the undertaking," whenever used in "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act" shall mean the Commissioner of Waterworks, and the words "special Act" shall mean this Act.

Interpretation. .

5. In the construction of and for the purposes of this Act and "The Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act," when not inconsistent with the context, the expression "the undertaking" shall, in addition to the meaning assigned thereto by the said "The "Adelaide City, Port, and Suburban Waterworks Act," mean and include the dam, wells, and all other works hereby authorised to be constructed; the expression "lands and streams" shall, in addition to the meaning assigned thereto by the said Act, mean and include the lands and streams of water hereby authorised to be taken or used for the purposes hereof; and the expression "water area" shall, in addition to the meaning assigned thereto by the said Act, mean and include the water area of Port Pirie, according as the same is defined in the Schedule hereto,

6. This Act may be for all purposes cited as the "Port Pirie Short title. Waterworks Act, 1879."

SCHEDULE.

Port Pirie Water Area. - Definition of Boundaries.

Commencing at the intersection of the southern side of road south of section 201, Hundred of Pirie, with the eastern side of road east of said section; thence north along eastern side of road aforesaid, and its production to a point east of the north-east corner of section 639; thence west by a straight line to said corner, and along the north boundaries of section 639, 632, and 627, across the road to the north-east corner of section 626; thence south along the western side of road east of section 626 and 385 to the south side of road south of section 87; thence east along said side of road to the point of commencement.
