An Act to amend the Police Regulation Act, 1952-1972.

[Assented to 30th August, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act Amendment Act, 1973". Short titles.

(2) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1972, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act, 1952-1973".

(3) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1972, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 38 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (2) the passage "special magistrate" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Judge, as defined for the purposes of the Local and District Criminal Courts Act, 1926-1972,". 4. Section 40 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the passage “special magistrate” and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “Judge, as defined for the purposes of the Local and District Criminal Courts Act, 1926-1972,”.
