An Act to amend the Public Service Act, 1936-1942. and the Public Service Act Amendment Act, 1942.

[Assented to 15th November, 1945.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1945".
- (2) The Public Service Act, 1936-1942, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Public Service Act, 1936-1945".
- (3) The Public Service Act, 1936-1942, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Section 4 of the Public Service Act Amendment Act, Amendment of 1942, is amended by striking out at the end thereof the words of 1942 shall come into force on a day to be fixed by the Governor by Leave of proclamation, being a day after the end of the war in which the absence for recreation. Commonwealth is engaged at the time of the passing of the Public Service Act Amendment Act, 1942", and inserting in lieu thereof the words "shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and forty-five ".

4. Section 75 of the principal Act is amended by striking out heater of brincipal Act.
