An Act to amend the Public Service Acts, 1916 to 1925.

[Assented to, December 2nd, 1931.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Act Amendment Act, 1931". Short title.

(2) The Public Service Acts, 1916 to 1925, and this Act may be cited together as the "Public Service Acts, 1916 to 1931".

(3) The Public Service Act, 1916, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 68 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after subsection (6) the following subsection :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 68—

(6a) If an officer pursuant to any arrangement operating in his department does not work on every working day, but works at least three days in every week, or six days in every fortnight, his service shall nevertheless be deemed to be continuous ; but in such a case in computing his service for the purpose of leave under this section he shall be credited with one week's service for every six days on which he actually works, although

the said days may be spread over two or more weeks. Saturday shall be regarded as a full day for the purpose of computing the said leave.

This section applies to any employee who has worked part time under any such arrangement since the nineteenth day of May, nineteen hundred and thirty.
