An Act to amend the Public Service Act, 1936-1953.

[Assented to 16th December, 1954.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Act Amendment Act (No. 2) 1954". Short titles.

(2) The Public Service Act, 1936-1953, as amended by this Act and any other Act passed in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-four, may be cited as the "Public Service Act, 1936-1954".

(3) The Public Service Act, 1936-1953, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. (1) Section 75a of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end of subsection (2) thereof the following proviso :— Amendment of
s. 75a of
principal Act—
Special leave.

Provided that where the leave is granted because of sickness arising from war service the abovementioned limitation shall not apply and the leave may be granted for any period which the Minister deems proper.

(2) The following subsection is inserted at the end of the said section 75a :—

(6) Where an officer has between 31st December, 1953, and the passing of the Public Service Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1954, been granted any leave without pay under this section and the Minister is satisfied that such leave was applied for and taken because of sickness arising from war service, the Minister may, in his discretion, direct that a payment be made to the officer of an amount equal to the salary of the officer for the period of the leave, less the amount of the war pension (if any) paid to him by the Commonwealth in respect of the same period.
