An Act to amend the Parliamentary Superannuation Act, 1948-1972.

[Assented to 20th September, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Superannuation Act Amendment Act, 1973".

(2) The Parliamentary Superannuation Act, 1948-1972, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Parliamentary Superannuation Act, 1948-1973".

(3) The Parliamentary Superannuation Act, 1948-1972, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Enactment of s. 16d of principal Act—

2. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act immediately after section 16c thereof:—

Supplementation of certain pensions.

16d. (1) In this section "determination day", in relation to a pension, means "determination day" as defined in subsection (2) of section 16b of this Act.

(2) Every pension payable under this Act—

(a) that had a determination day that occurred before the thirtieth day of June, 1972;

and

(b) that was payable immediately before the day fixed by proclamation for the purposes of this section, which proclamation the Governor is hereby empowered to make,

shall on and from the day so fixed by proclamation be increased by eight and seven-tenths per cent.
