An Act to amend the Public Supply and Tender Act, 1914-1975.

[Assented to 26th February, 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Supply and Tender Act Amendment Act, 1981".
- (2) The Public Supply and Tender Act, 1914-1975, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Public Supply and Tender Act, 1914-1981".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Repeal of s. 15c and substitution of new sections. 3. Section 15c of the principal Act is repealed and the following sections are substituted:

Power of

- 15c. (1) The Board may delegate any of its powers or functions under this Act—
  - (a) to any instrumentality or agency of the Crown, or of the Government of the State, or to a member or officer of any such instrumentality or agency;

or

- (b) to any officer or member of the public service.
- (2) A delegation under this section may be made upon such conditions as the Board thinks fit.
  - (3) A delegation under this section—
    - (a) is revocable at will;

and

(b) does not derogate from the power of the Board to act in any matter itself.

15d. No contract made before the commencement of the Public Saving Supply and Tender Act Amendment Act, 1981, is void or voidable by reason of non-compliance with a provision of this Act.
