## **GEORGII VI REGIS.**

A.D. 1940.

## No. 3 of 1940.

An Act to apply, out of the General Revenue, a further sum of One Million Pounds to the Public Service for the Year ending the Thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and forty-one.

[Assented to 29th August, 1940.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act (No. 2), 1940".

Issue and application of £1,000,000.

2. Out of the General Revenue of the State there shall be issued and applied, from time to time, for the public service of the State for the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and forty-one, in addition to any sum or sums of money so issued and applied pursuant to the Supply Act (No. 1), 1940, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of one million pounds.

Payments not to exceed last year's Estimates.

- 3. No payments for any establishment or service shall be made out of the said sum in excess of the rates voted for similar establishments or services on the Estimates for the financial year ended the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and forty, except such payments as are necessary to pay any annual increases of salary fixed by—
  - (a) any return which has been made by the Classification and Efficiency Board under the Public Service Act, 1936-1938, or any previous Act relating to the Public Service, and is for the time being in force; or
  - (b) any regulation made by the South Australian Railways Commissioner and confirmed by the Governor-in-Council and for the time being in force:

Provided that this section shall not authorize the payment of any increase whereby any salary is increased to a sum exceeding three hundred and eight pounds per annum.

- 4. (1) All money appropriated from the Governor's Appropriation Fund to meet expenditure incurred between the Appropriation thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and forty, and the commencement of this Act, shall be recouped to the Governor's Appropriation Fund out of the money voted by this Act, to the intent that the Governor shall thereafter have power to appropriate revenue under the authority of subsection (1) of section 72 of the Constitution Act, 1934-1939, to the full extent and for the purposes permitted by that subsection.
- (2) In this section "Governor's Appropriation Fund" means the Governor's Appropriation Fund as defined by subsection (2) of section 72 of the Constitution Act, 1934-1939.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
