An Act to apply, out of the General Revenue, the sum of Seven Hundred and Twenty Thousand Five Hundred and Eighty-eight Pounds Two Shillings, to the service of the Year ending the Thirtieth Day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six.

[Assented to, 15th October, 1875.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

Preamble.

1. Out of the General Revenue of the said Province there shall be issued and applied, from time to time, for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Seven Hundred and Twenty Thousand Five Hundred and Eighty-eight Pounds Two Shillings to such services as shall then have been voted by the House of Assembly aforesaid.
