An Act to amend the Superannuation Act, 1969-1972.

*[Assented to 30th November, 1972]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Superannuation Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1972". Short titles.
- (2) The Superannuation Act, 1969-1972, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Superannuation Act, 1969-1972".
- (3) The Superannuation Act, 1969-1972, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
  
2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.
  
3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act immediately after section 56 thereof:— Enactment of s. 56a of principal Act—
  - 56a. (1) A female contributor who has not made an election under section 55 of this Act and who does not retire on reaching the age of sixty years shall not, upon attaining the age of sixty years, be required or entitled to make any further contributions Service after age sixty years in case of females.

to the Fund, other than contributions referred to in subsection (4) of section 25 of this Act, but she shall not be entitled to receive any pension in respect of the units for which she was contributing until she retires.

(2) Where a contributor referred to in subsection (1) of this section retires after attaining the age of sixty-one years there shall be paid out of the Fund to that contributor on her retirement, in addition to her pension, such amount as determined by the Board having regard to the length of the period during which her contributions have remained in the Fund and to the length of the period during which payment of the proportion of pension relating to those contributions has been postponed.

(3) Where a contributor referred to in subsection (1) of this section, after attaining the age of sixty-one years, dies before retirement, subsection (2) of this section shall have effect as if the contributor had retired immediately before she died and the payment required to be made by that subsection shall be made to her personal representative or such other person or persons as the Board determines.
