An Act to amend the Sandalwood Act, 1930.

[Assented to, 26th November, 1936.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sandalwood Act Amendment Act, 1936". Short titles.

(2) The Sandalwood Acts, 1930 and 1933, and this Act may be cited together as the "Sandalwood Acts, 1930 to 1936".

(3) The Sandalwood Act, 1930, is in this Act called "the principal Act". 1936, 1930.

2. This Act is incorporated with the Sandalwood Acts, 1930 and 1933, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definition of "sandalwood" therein and inserting in lieu of that definition the following :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 2—
Definition of "sandalwood".

"sandalwood" means the wood of any tree of the genus *santalum* or the genus *fusanus* and any other species of aromatic wood which is or may be used as a substitute for sandalwood.

4. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven" and inserting in lieu thereof "thirty-first day of October, nineteen hundred and forty". Amendment of principal Act, s. 11—
Duration of Act.
