An Act to amend the Superannuation Act, 1926-1955.

[Assented to 15th November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Superannuation Act Amendment Act, 1956."
- (2) The Superannuation Act, 1926-1955, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Superannuation Act, 1926-1956".
- (3) The Superannuation Act, 1926-1955, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of s. 24s of principal Act— Rights of contributors. 3. Section 24a of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end of subsection (3) the following proviso:—Provided also that a professional railways officer who received an increase of salary operative as from the thirteenth day of February, 1955, as a result of the order made under the Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1902-1952 of the Commonwealth on the eighth day of March, 1956, may make an election under this section at any time before the first day of February, 1957.

Amendment of s. 34 of principal Act— Period of service to qualify for pension. 4. Section 34 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following additional proviso:—

Provided also that if the Public Service Commissioner certifies that in his opinion it is desirable in the public

interest that an employee should be exempted from the requirement of ten years service as a condition of pension under this section and section 41, and such employee complies with the other conditions entitling him to such pension, he shall be entitled to such pension on retirement at the age prescribed by this section although he has not then been in the service for ten years.
