An Act to amend the Sandalwood Act, 1930-1936, so as to extend the period of operation thereof.

[Assented to 26th September, 1940.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sandalwood Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1940".
- (2) The Sandalwood Act, 1930-1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Sandalwood Act, 1930-1940".
- (3) The Sandalwood Act, 1930-1936, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking Repeal of section 11 of out the word "forty" therein and inserting in lieu thereof principal Act the word "forty-three".
