An Act to amend the Magistrates Court Act 1991 and the Supreme Court Act 1935.

[Assented to 18 November 1999]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

**PART 1
PRELIMINARY**

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Statutes Amendment (Magistrates Court Appeals) Act 1999*.

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Interpretation

3. A reference in this Act to the principal Act is a reference to the Act referred to in the heading to the Part in which the reference occurs.

**PART 2
AMENDMENT OF MAGISTRATES COURT ACT 1991**

Amendment of s. 42—Appeals

4. Section 42 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (2) and substituting the following paragraph:

(b) in any other case—to the Supreme Court constituted of a single Judge (but the Judge may, if he or she thinks fit, refer the appeal for hearing and determination by the Full Court).;

(b) by striking out subsection (3).

Amendment of s. 43—Cases stated

5. Section 43 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (2) and substituting the following paragraph:

- (b) in any other case—for determination by the Supreme Court constituted of a single Judge (but the Judge may, if he or she thinks fit, refer the matter for determination by the Full Court).

**PART 3
AMENDMENT OF SUPREME COURT ACT 1935**

Amendment of s. 50—Appeals against decisions of judges and masters

6. Section 50 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (a) of subclause (3) of the proviso to subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraph:

- (a) an order on appeal from the Magistrates Court:.
