An Act to amend the Magistrates Court Act 1991 and the Supreme Court Act 1935.

[Assented to 18 November 1999]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

### PART 1 PRELIMINARY

#### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Statutes Amendment (Magistrates Court Appeals) Act 1999.

#### Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

#### Interpretation

3. A reference in this Act to the principal Act is a reference to the Act referred to in the heading to the Part in which the reference occurs.

### PART 2 AMENDMENT OF MAGISTRATES COURT ACT 1991

### Amendment of s. 42-Appeals

- 4. Section 42 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (2) and substituting the following paragraph:
  - (b) in any other case—to the Supreme Court constituted of a single Judge (but the Judge may, if he or she thinks fit, refer the appeal for hearing and determination by the Full Court).;
- (b) by striking out subsection (3).

#### Amendment of s. 43—Cases stated

- 5. Section 43 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (2) and substituting the following paragraph:
  - (b) in any other case—for determination by the Supreme Court constituted of a single Judge (but the Judge may, if he or she thinks fit, refer the matter for determination by the Full Court).

# PART 3 AMENDMENT OF SUPREME COURT ACT 1935

### Amendment of s. 50-Appeals against decisions of judges and masters

- 6. Section 50 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (a) of subclause (3) of the proviso to subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraph:
  - (a) an order on appeal from the Magistrates Court:.
