An Act to amend the South Australian Housing Trust Act, 1936-1965.

[Assented to 21st October, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Housing Trust Act Amendment Act, 1971".
- (2) The South Australian Housing Trust Act, 1936-1965, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "South Australian Housing Trust Act, 1936-1971".
- (3) The South Australian Housing Trust Act, 1936-1965, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 20—
General powers of the trust.

- 2. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from subsection (1) the word "and" immediately following paragraph (h);

(b) by inserting in subsection (1) immediately after paragraph (i) the following passage:

and

(j) exercise any power conferred on the trust by or under any other Act.
