An Act to amend the Agent-General Act, 1901-1953, the Audit Act, 1921-1957, the Industrial Code, 1920-1958, the Police Regulation Act, 1952-1955, and the Public Service Act, 1936-1958, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 5th November, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutes Amendment Short title. (Public Salaries) Act, 1959".
- 2. 5. Section 8 of the Police Regulation Act, 1952-1955, is amended by striking out the words "three thousand five hundred and seventy-six" in subsection (1) thereof and inserting in their place the words "three thousand nine hundred and forty".

Amendment of Public Service Act, 1936-1958, s. 17— Salary of Public Service Commissioner.

6. Section 17 of the Public Service Act, 1936-1958, is amended by striking out the words "three thousand eight hundred and seventy-six" in subsection (1) thereof and inserting in their place the words "four thousand two hundred and forty".

Operation of increases in salarles.

7. The rates of salary fixed by sections 2 to 6 (inclusive) of this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, and the rate fixed by section 3 shall for all purposes be deemed to be the salary at which the Auditor-General holding office on the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, was being paid at the time of his retirement.

Retrospective increase in certain salaries.

8. The Governor may direct that any increase made in the rate of salary of the South Australian Railways Commissioner or of the Commissioner of Highways in force on the day on which this Act is assented to by the Governor shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, or any later date fixed by the Governor.

Arrears.

- 9. (1) The arrears of salary payable to any person by virtue of this Act may be paid in one sum.
- (2) This Act shall, without further appropriation, be sufficient authority for the payment of all such arrears.
