An Act to amend the Audit Act, 1921-1971 ; the Police Regulation Act, 1952-1972 ; the Public Service Act, 1967-1971 ; the Valuation of Land Act, 1971 ; and the Agent-General Act, 1901-1971 ; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

AMENDMENT OF AUDIT ACT

3. (1) The Audit Act, 1921-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Audit Act, 1921-1972". Short titles.

(2) The Audit Act, 1921-1971, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

4. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 6—

(1) As from, and including, the twenty-sixth day of June, 1972, the Auditor-General shall receive a salary at the rate of twenty-one thousand three hundred dollars a year. Salary of Auditor-General.

5. (1) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1972, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act, 1952-1972". Short titles.

(2) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1972, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

6. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 8—

(1) As from, and including, the twenty-sixth day of June, 1972, the salary of the Commissioner shall be at the rate of nineteen thousand seven hundred dollars a year. Salary of Commissioner.

## Short titles.

7. (1) The Public Service Act, 1967-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Public Service Act, 1967-1972".

(2) The Public Service Act, 1967-1971, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

8. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(1) As from, and including, the twenty-sixth day of June, 1972, the salary of the Commissioner nominated Chairman of the Board shall be at the rate of twenty-one thousand three hundred dollars a year and the salary of each other Commissioner shall be at the rate of eighteen thousand two hundred dollars a year.

## Short titles.

9. (1) The Valuation of Land Act, 1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Valuation of Land Act, 1971-1972".

(2) The Valuation of Land Act, 1971, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

10. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(1) As from, and including, the twenty-sixth day of June, 1972, the Valuer-General shall receive a salary at the rate of thirteen thousand four hundred dollars a year.

## AMENDMENT OF AGENT-GENERAL ACT

11. (1) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Agent-General Act, 1901-1972". Short titles.

(2) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1971, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

12. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (b) from subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 5—  
Salary and allowances of Agent-General.

(b) as from and including the twenty-sixth day of June, 1972, an expense allowance at the rate of four thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds sterling a year.
