An Act to amend the Public Service Act, 1936-1954,
and the Education Act, 1915-1954.

[Assented to 27th November, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament
thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Statutes Amendment Short titles.
(Long Service Leave) Act, 1958".
- (2) The Public Service Act, 1936-1954, as amended by this
Act may be cited as the "Public Service Act, 1936-1958".
- (3) The Education Act, 1915-1954, as amended by this Act
may be cited as the "Education Act, 1915-1958".
2. Section 3 of this Act is incorporated with the Public Incorporation.
Service Act, 1936-1954, and section 4 of this Act is incorporated
with the Education Act, 1915-1954.
3. Subsection (1c) of section 75 of the Public Service Act, Amendment of
Public Service
Act, 1936-1954,
s.75—
1936-1954, is amended by striking out the words "three
hundred and sixty-five" in the second line and by inserting
in lieu thereof the words "four hundred and fifty". Long leave of
absence.
4. Section 18a of the Education Act, 1915-1954, is amended— Amendment of
Education Act,
1915-1954,
s.18a—
(i) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and by
inserting in lieu thereof the following :— Long Service
Leave.

- (b) In respect of each complete year of continuous service in excess of fifteen, not more than nine days leave on full salary.
- (ii) by striking out the words "one hundred and eighty" in the second line of subsection (2) and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "two hundred and seventy".
