An Act to amend the Savings Bank of South Australia Act. 1929-1958.

[Assented to 26th November, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Savings Bank of South short titles. Australia Act Amendment Act, 1959".
- (2) The Savings Bank of South Australia Act, 1929-1958, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Savings Bank of South Australia Act, 1929-1959".
- (3) The Savings Bank of South Australia Act, 1929-1958, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. The following section is inserted in the principal Act after Enactment of section 20a thereof—

20b. The trustees may by resolution provide or make Medical and arrangements for the provision of a medical and hospital hospital benefit benefit scheme for the benefit of officers, clerks, and servants of the Bank and may pay out of the funds of the Bank to any such officers, clerks, and servants such sum or sums as shall be determined by the trustees from time
