An Act to amend the Savings Bank of South Australia Act, 1929-1958.

[Assented to 26th November, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Savings Bank of South Australia Act Amendment Act, 1959". Short titles.

(2) The Savings Bank of South Australia Act, 1929-1958, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Savings Bank of South Australia Act, 1929-1959".

(3) The Savings Bank of South Australia Act, 1929-1958, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The following section is inserted in the principal Act after section 20a thereof— Enactment of s. 20b—

20b. The trustees may by resolution provide or make arrangements for the provision of a medical and hospital benefit scheme for the benefit of officers, clerks, and servants of the Bank and may pay out of the funds of the Bank to any such officers, clerks, and servants such sum or sums as shall be determined by the trustees from time

to time in accordance with such arrangements in respect of medical or hospital expenses incurred by any such officers, clerks, and servants in respect of themselves, their wives, and children under eighteen years of age.
