An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1967.

[Assented to 27th February, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1969".
- (2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1967, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969".
- (3) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1967, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 12— Salaries of Judges.

- 2. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—
 - (1) Until the date of commencement of the Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1969, the salary of the Chief Justice and the salary of every puisne judge shall be at the rates respectively prescribed by this Act as in force immediately prior to that date and on and after that date the salary of the Chief Justice shall be at the rate of nineteen thousand four hundred dollars a year and the salary of every puisne judge shall be at the rate of seventeen thousand five hundred dollars a year.;

- (b) by inserting after the word "The" being the first word in subsection (2) the word "increased"; and
- (c) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "this Act" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "the Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1969".
