An Act to amend the Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1946.

[Assented to 27th September, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Swine Compensation short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1951."

(2) The Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1946, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1951 ".

(3) The Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1946, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. The definition of "disease" in section 4 of the principal $\frac{\text{Amendment of principal Act}}{\text{Act is amended by striking out the words "swine plague" <math>\frac{\text{A}}{\text{s. 4}}$ and by inserting in lieu thereof the passage "infectious disease." pneumonia of swine (including swine plague), swine dysentery,".
