An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1978.

[Assented to 3rd July, 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1980".
- (2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1980".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 13a— Retirement of judges, etc.

- 2. Section 13a of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—
 - (1) A judge shall retire on reaching the age of seventy years.;

and

- (b) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:—
 - (3) A judge who retires on reaching the age of seventy years, or who resigns before reaching that age, may nevertheless complete the hearing and determination of any proceedings part-heard by him before his retirement or resignation and, in relation to any such proceedings, shall be deemed to continue as a judge.
