An Act to amend the Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1975.

[Assented to 16th November, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Swine Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1978". Short titles.

(2) The Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1975, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1978".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "an amount of" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "a prescribed amount not exceeding";

and

(b) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "twenty-one cents" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "a prescribed maximum amount (being an amount not exceeding twenty-one cents)".
