## No. 82 of 1982

An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1981.

[Assented to 16 September 1982]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1982". Short titles.

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1982".

2. Section 13h of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting in subsections (1), (3), (4) and (5) after the word "judge" wherever it occurs the passage "or master";

and

(b) by inserting in subsection (2) after the word "judge" where it first occurs the passage "or master";

(c) by striking out from the second sentence of subsection (2) the passage "judge's salary" and substituting the passage "salary of the judge or master";

and

(d) by inserting after subsection (5) the following subsection:

(6) This section shall not apply to a master who was, immediately before the commencement of the Statutes Amendment (Administration of Courts and Tribunals) Act, 1981, the master or a deputy master of the court.
