An Act to further amend the State Children Act, 1895.

[Assented to, November 27th, 1918.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "State Children Further Amendment Act, 1918." Short titles.

(2) The State Children Acts, 1895 to 1909, and this Act may be cited together as the "State Children Acts, 1895 to 1918."

(3) The State Children Act, 1895, is hereby referred to as "the principal Act." No. 641 of 1895.

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with other Acts.

3. Section 36 of the principal Act is further amended by inserting therein at the end of subdivision (a) thereof the following words:—"or for such lesser period as such Judge or Justices in their discretion deem proper." Amendment of principal Act, s. 36—
Convicted children may be sent to reformatory school until 18.

4. Section 78 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word "Ten" in the third line thereof the word "Eleven." Amendment of *ibid.*, s. 78—
Payments for maintenance of State children.
