## No. 5.

An Act to further amend the Supreme Court Procedure Amendment Act, No. 5 of 1853.

[Assented to, 24th December, 1858.]

THEREAS it is desirable to amend the Supreme Court Procedure Preamble. Amendment Act, No. 5 of 1853, by repealing clauses Nos. 182 and 183—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:
