An Act to amend the Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1959.

[Assented to 2nd November, 1961.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Stock Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1961".
- (2) The Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1959, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1961".
- (3) The Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1959, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of s, 8 of principal Act— Power of Governor to make regulations. 3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "the permit" in paragraph XI of that section and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the certificates of health and the permit or any of them".
