An Act to amend the State Lotteries Act, 1966-1975.

[Assented to 7th December, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Lotteries Act Amendment Act, 1978".

(2) The State Lotteries Act, 1966-1975, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "State Lotteries Act, 1966-1978".

Offences.**

2. Section 19 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after subsection (10) the following subsection:—

(10a) A person shall not, without the written authority of the Commission, distribute, display or publish, or cause to be distributed, displayed or published, by any means, any notice or advertisement in which the word "Lotto" with the addition of the word "Cross" or the letter, symbol or character "X" or any other words, letters, symbols or characters is used as a title or description of a lottery other than a lottery conducted, or to be conducted, by the Commission.

Penalty: Two hundred dollars.;

and

(b) by striking out from subsection (12) the passage "or (10)" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage ", (10) or (10a)".
