An Act to amend the State Lotteries Act, 1966.

[Assented to 20 March 1986]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Lotteries Act Amendment Act, 1986". Short title.

(2) The State Lotteries Act, 1966, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (5) the passage "of three members" and substituting the passage "of not less than 3 nor more than 5 members". Amendment of s. 4—
Constitution of the Commission.

4. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:

(2a) A quorum at a meeting of the Commission is constituted—

(a) if the number of members for the time being is five or four, by three members;

and

(b) if the number of members for the time being is three, by two members.;

and

Amendment of s. 9—
Quorum.

(b) by striking out from subsection (3) the passage "Any two members shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the Commission and".
