An Act to amend the Stock Mortgages and Wool Liens Act, 1924.

[Assented to 22 December 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Stock Mortgages and Wool Liens Act Amendment Act, 1983". Short title.

(2) The Stock Mortgages and Wool Liens Act, 1924, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "thirty" and substituting the word "sixty". Amendment of s. 5—
Stock mortgages.

4. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the word "thirty" and substituting the word "sixty". Amendment of s. 14—
Owner of sheep may grant preferable lien on wool.

5. Section 23 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "and, until a day to be fixed by proclamation, shall be on paper of demy size and of foolscap size respectively, but, on and after that day, shall be on International paper size A4 (297 mm x 210 mm)". Amendment of s. 23—
Execution.

6. Section 24 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph *(b)* and the word “and” occurring immediately before that paragraph;

and

(b) by striking out subsection (2).

7. Section 25 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage “, fifth, sixth, and seventh” and substituting the passage “and fifth”.
