An Act to amend the Summary Offences Act, 1953; and to repeal the Pawnbrokers Act, 1888.

[Assented to 22 November 1990]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Summary Offences Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1990*.
- (2) The *Summary Offences Act, 1953*, is referred to in this Act as “the principal Act”.

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Interpretation

3. Section 49 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after “principal or agent” in the definition of “second-hand dealer” in subsection (1) “and includes a person who carries on business as a pawnbroker”.

Expiation of prescribed traffic offences

4. Section 64 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from paragraph (b) of subsection (4a) “147” and substituting “146”;
 - and
 - (b) by striking out from subsection (4b) “section 147” wherever it occurs and substituting, in each case, “section 146”.

Repeal of Pawnbrokers Act, 1888

5. The *Pawnbrokers Act, 1888*, is repealed.
